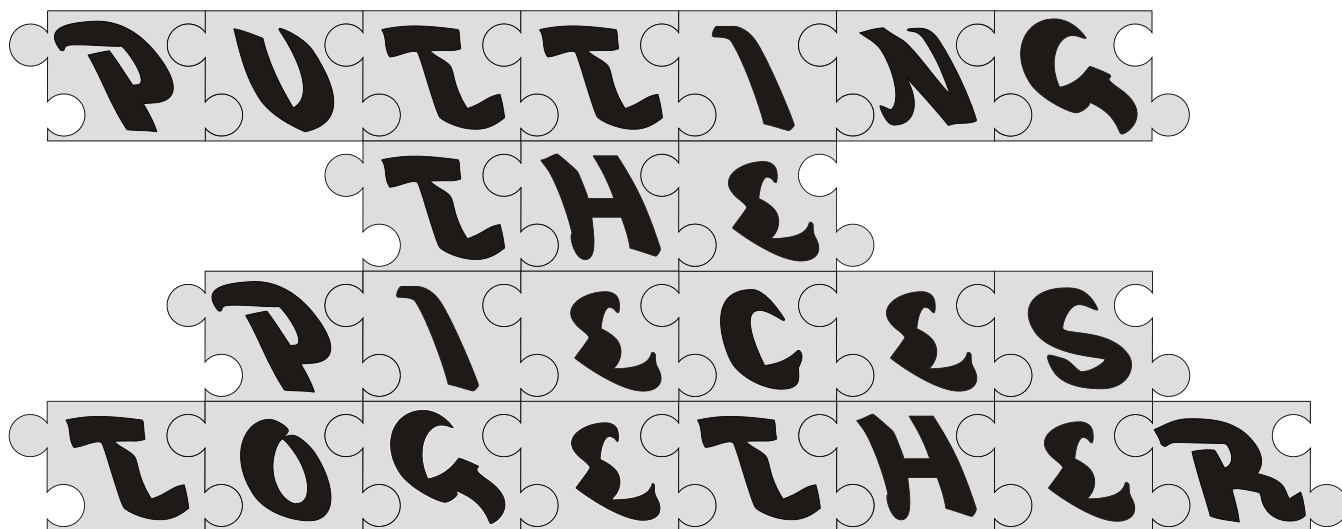

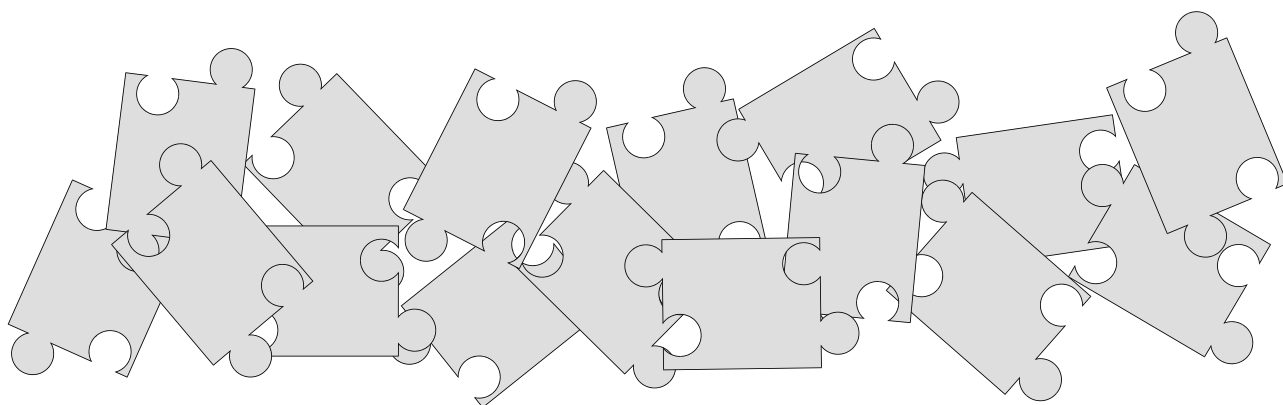
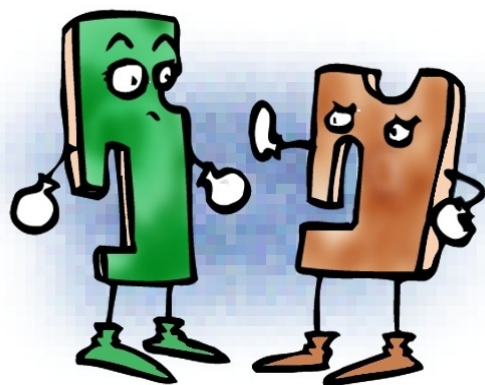
Putting the Pieces Together puzzle pieces

1 or 2

Directions

1. Cut out the squares in the puzzle.
2. One puzzle sheet is used for one or two players.
3. The students can be divided into pairs or play by themselves.
4. The students place the puzzle pieces together so that touching edges match a number sentence to its solution.
5. When finished, the smaller squares should create one large square.
