

## **Materials**

For each pair of students: *Yard by Yard* spinner Yardstick or measuring tape 2 game tokens (2 colors)

## **Number of Players**


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
## **Directions**


- 1. Divide the students into pairs.
- 2. The student closest in height to a yard is Player 2.
- 3. Both players put their game token at zero on the shared yardstick.
- 4. Player 1 begins by spinning the spinner.
- 5. If (s)he lands on four inches, Player 1 moves his or her game token four inches on the yardstick.
- 6. Player 2 spins the spinner and moves his or her game token the amount shown on the spinner.
- 7. Play continues with each player taking a turn until a player's token reaches or exceeds a yard.
- 8. The winner is the first player to reach or exceed one yard.

## Variation

Make it harder by having the winner get exactly one yard and/or by having the students record their answers on paper, keeping a running total as they play the game.







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
